








## Residents: Improving our Local Community Transport for the future

## Six Councils survey - Introduction for Residents

Are you interested in exploring ways to improve how we travel around our communities, perhaps enabling a reduction in carbon emissions and private car use? Llangattock Community Council have obtained funding from Aberystwyth University's Transport and Health Integrated Research Network (THINK), to explore potential ways of improving local travel in the Six Councils area (see map). We want to support Bannau Brycheiniog National Park in their goal of reducing emissions and this runs alongside the Place Plan work of Local Councils as well as project work by Llangattock Green Valleys and the Race to Zero Crickhowell group.



Six Councils area map

This survey assesses the levels of demand and the types of transport that could serve the six communities in the context of the climate emergency, transport

poverty and access to health & wellbeing. Our aims are to reduce dependency on private car travel, help alleviate parking congestion, reduce emissions and to enable access or ensure continued access for those in our community who cannot drive and may be isolated. We will need local innovative solutions for the future.

Community transport provides flexible and accessible community-led solutions in response to unmet local transport needs and often represents the only means of transport for many vulnerable and isolated people. Most are demand-responsive, taking people from door to door, but a growing number are scheduled services along fixed routes where conventional bus services aren't available. We would envisage any new local shuttle bus needing to be a frequent service, if we are going to alter local transport habits. Peer to peer car share schemes use peoples existing vehicles in an informal arrangement, whereby people co-ordinate their journeys or share vehicles. Car share clubs are membership schemes whereby you can book and borrow a vehicle.
